## What Are The Differences Between a Grant Agreement and a Grant Letter (Consular Letter)?

### Delivery of the Acceptance Letter by the Partner University

---

As soon as the acceptance letter is sent to you by the host institution, Erasmus Office must be informed by sending it to the e-mail address of [erasmus@uskudar.edu.tr](mailto:erasmus@uskudar.edu.tr). And then an appointment must be made for the visa applications from the relevant country's consulate.

IMPORTANT! Grant letter (consular letter) requests must be sent to [erasmus@uskudar.edu.tr](mailto:erasmus@uskudar.edu.tr) at the latest one week before the appointment date. The preparation of the document by our university takes at least a week.

### Grant Letter (or) Consulate Letter

---

Two of the most important official documents required for a visa application are the consulate letter and the acceptance letter. The consulate letter is also known as the grant/confirmation letter in some of the visa application centers. The document requested by the consulate is not the grant agreement, but the grant letter. The grant agreement which will be signed between the student and the Turkish National Agency represented by the Üsküdar University is a legal document and the original copy should be submitted to another organization. If it is mandatory to present the agreement, a copy must be used instead of the original document.

### Signing the Grant Agreement

---

It is sufficient to submit the "consulate letter" in your visa application. After receiving the acceptance letter from the partner university, you must come to our office in person and submit the following documents for the grant contract to be signed.

- 1) [Health Insurance Policy](#)
- 2) A copy of the Euro Passbook opened at Yapı Kredi Bank

## Essential Notes

---

If the partner university or the consulate requests a health insurance policy from you that covers the coverage other than the health insurance coverage requested by Üsküdar University, you can use that policy as the health insurance policy required to sign a grant contract.
